



Chief Groundsperson Position Description

The Role

The Chief Groundsperson is responsible for ensuring SV State Championships are conducted at appropriate facilities, and that the needs of the activity are met for the duration of the event.

Key Accountabilities

The Chief Groundsperson will:

- Ensure appropriate facilities are selected for State Championships
 - Assist Host Associations in the preparation and organisation of grounds for State Championships
 - Work with the Competitions Administrator to ensure appropriate diamonds are allocated for State Championships
 - Work with the Competition & Events Committee and Host Association to recruit volunteers to assist with the upkeep of grounds during State Championships
 - Be primary point of contact for grounds issues arising during an State Championships
- Support other RVP's to fulfil their duties (eg Competition Administrator)

Attributes

The Tournament Convenor will have:-

- A strong understanding of SV rules
- Experience in the preparation of diamonds for softball competitions/tournaments/events/activities
- Strong interpersonal communication skills
- Not be appointed to a position on a representative team or be intending to apply for a position
