



## ***Chief Umpire Position Description***

### **The Role**

The Chief Umpire is responsible for leading the Umpire Committee, and championing the umpire development program in Victoria.

### **Key Accountabilities**

The Chief Umpire will:

- Chair the Umpire Committee
- Provide support to the members of the Umpire Committee to carry out their duties
- Liaise with and carry out the directions of the National Umpires In Chief
- In conjunction with other members of the Committee consider recommendation to SAL, of umpires nominating for National Tournaments
- Ensure that SAL criteria, in relation to National Accreditation and theory examinations, are met, and that umpires in Victoria are advised of all relevant information

### **Attributes**

The Chief Umpire will have:-

- A strong understanding of State, National and ISF rule variations,
- Experience leading teams
- Strong interpersonal communication skills
